Curriculum Corner:



ELA: Module 1: Poetry, Poets, and Becoming Writers

In Unit 1: Reading and Analyzing Famous Poems, the students are introduced to poetry through *Love That Dog*, a novel written in verse by Sharon Creech. We have already begun to establish our reading routine of the novel beginning with reading and summarizing the novel to determine what the main character Jack, is learning about poetry and begins to write his own poetry. Next, students will analyze one of the famous poems that Jack has read in his class to begin determining the characteristics of poetry.

Math: Unit 1: Building a Mathematical Community Through Data
This unit, which focuses on data, serves as a platform to help establish routines within the math community. We will work on building math community.
Students will practice collaboration and math talk while forming questions and collecting and analyzing data. We will also work on fostering growth mindsets in which all students can be mathematicians and learn math at the highest levels.
Nightly, math homework will begin this week. We will have our end of unit test on Friday. Feel free to check out the class website for resources to help with homework or just extra practice.

STEM:

We will continue to work on team-building activities learning about the Engineering Design Process and the different collaborative roles for teamwork. The students will be introduced to our classroom STEM stations that will be used during arrival/dismissal and periodically throughout the school day as well as setting up their student accounts and portfolio for Google Classroom.
